George Petrocheilos is a Partner at Camden Partners Holdings, LLC. In 2016, he co-founded Camden Partners Nexus, the firm's venture capital strategy, and is making investments in early-stage biomedical technology companies (drugs, devices, diagnostics) with strong intellectual property, existing federal funding and world-renowned scientists-entrepreneurs.

He currently sits on the board of Sisu Global Health, Inc., WindMIL Therapeutics, Ashvattha Therapeutics, Cage Pharmaceuticals and eNeura, Inc. He also serves on the board of directors of the family-owned PETKA S.A., a construction & development company headquartered in Athens, Greece.

George also spent a year at Towne Park Holdings, LLC, a Camden Partners portfolio company at the time, which is one of the world's largest parking companies. He was working directly for Towne Park's Founder, Chairman & CEO, Jerry B. South. George was also a portfolio analyst for Global Domain Partners, a managed futures hedge fund, focusing on asset allocation research & strategy.

On the non-profit side, George currently serves on the Board of Trustees of The Baltimore School for the Arts, The Johns Hopkins Center for Financial Economics, The Johns Hopkins Medicine Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences Advisory Board and the Director's Circle of the Greater Baltimore Cultural Alliance, supporting the work of emerging local artists. He has previously served on the Board of Trustees of the The Living Classrooms Foundation and the

Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. George is also a founding member of the Johns Hopkins Center of Talented Youth Greece Program. In 2013-14 George was the co-chair of the Baltimore Police Department's Capital Campaign and he is currently a member of the Archbishop Iakovos 'Leadership 100' Endowment Fund, which supports the National Ministries of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese in advancement of Orthodoxy and Hellenism.
